**8. HOLDING OF CLASSES:** Only exhibitors who have back-to-back classes may request a 2 minute hold. Request forms are available in the horse show office and **must be made one hour before the session in which the conflict occurs.**

**9. REFUNDS:** No refund on canceled entries & stalls after closing date. Refund on entries fees only with a Vets certificate.

**10. INDEBTEDNESS:** Any indebtedness to this show will result in the return of entries & the points of the individual member causing the debt will be withheld until the debt is paid in full. Future entries will be refused.

**11. CHANGES:** The show committee welcomes suggestions for the show, however; due to schedule and time constraints, we are only able to add classes where TBA classes are listed.

**12. RING PROCEDURE AND CONDUCT:** A maximum of 2 minutes to enter the ring after the class is called and the first entrant is in the ring will be allowed
